- **Selector 2: Default reduction rate for failure of automatic reduction during recording**
This selector sets the default reduction rate to be applied if the automatic reduction function fails to record one-page data sent from the calling station in a single page of the current recording paper.
If it is set to "0," the equipment records one-page data at full size (100%) without reduction; if it is set to "1," the equipment records it at the size* specified according to the current paper size.
(*American versions allow the user to select the desired paper size from the control panel. According to the paper size setting, the equipment determines the reduction rate. Other versions can handle only A4-size paper, so the reduction rate is always 87%.)
- **Selector 5: Minimum short-OFF duration in distinctive ringing**
The ringer pattern consists of short and long rings, e.g., short-short-long rings. This selector sets the minimum OFF duration following a short ring in order to avoid missing ringer tones in distinctive ringing.
If this selector is set to "1," when the short-OFF duration is a minimum of 90 ms long, then the equipment will interpret the short-OFF as OFF.
- **Selector 8: "CHANGE DRUM SOON" message**
This selector determines whether or not the "CHANGE DRUM SOON" message should appear on the LCD when the service life of the laser-sensitive drum in the laser unit will expire soon.

If you do not pack the machine properly, you may void your warranty. Select a place that is free of vibration and shocks. Locate the machine near a telephone jack and a standard, grounded power outlet. Do not place near heaters, air conditioners, water, chemicals or refrigerators. We do not recommend using the toll saver feature on your external answering machine if it exceeds 4 rings. Your machine cannot work properly if you plug the TAD into a wall jack. If your TAD is plugged into a wall jack, both your machine and the TAD will try to control the phone line. See illustration on page 210. The message sets up the ways to handle both manual and automatic fax reception. For example “ After the beep, leave a message or send a fax by pressing 5 1 and Start.” You may try omitting this pause, but if your machine has trouble receiving, then you must rerecord the OGM to include it. The calls are usually passed down or “rolled over” to the next available phone line in a preset order. Do not put the machine on any of the other numbers; when the other lines are busy and a second fax call is received, the fax call would be transferred to a line that does not have a fax machine. Your machine will work best on a dedicated line. The two phone numbers can be on separate jacks RJ11 or combined into one jack RJ14. Your machine must be plugged into an RJ11 jack. RJ11 and RJ14 jacks may be equal in size and appearance and both may contain four wires black, red, green, yellow. To test the type of jack, plug in a twoline phone and see if it can access both lines. If it can, you must separate the line for your machine. The first two ways may require assistance from the telephone company. You can change the wall outlets from one RJ14 jack to two RJ11 jacks. Or, you can have an RJ11 wall outlet installed and slave or jump one of the phone numbers to it. You can plug a triplex adapter into an RJ14 outlet. It separates the wires into two separate RJ11 jacks Line 1, Line 2 and a third RJ14 jack Lines 1 and 2. If your machine is on Line 1, plug the machine into L1 of the triplex adapter. If your machine is on Line 2, plug it into L2 of the triplex adapter. The most common connection is to put the machine on Line 2, which is our assumption in the following steps.

You will need at least three telephone line cords, the one that came with your machine and two for your external twoline TAD. You will need a fourth line cord if you add a twoline telephone. Plug the other end into the LINE jack on the left side of the machine. Plug the other end into the EXT. There are two ways to add a twoline telephone to the machine’s wall outlet. Or, you can plug the twoline telephone into the TEL jack of the twoline TAD. While it is often relatively simple to connect the machine to a key system or a PBX Private Branch Exchange, we suggest that you contact the company that installed your telephone system and ask them to connect the machine for you. It is advisable to have a separate line for the machine. You can then leave the machine in FAX mode to receive faxes any time of day or night. This prevents the unit from being activated each time a telephone call is received. If your line has more than two wires, proper connection of the machine cannot be made. Any cases of difficulty should be reported first to the company that handles your PBX. All incoming calls should initially be regarded as telephone calls. Userfriendly programming helps you take full advantage of all the functions your machine has to offer. See Using This Manual, page 11. All you need to do is follow the prompts as they guide you through the function menu selections and programming options and settings. When you enter the function mode, your machine displays a list of main menu options which scroll on the display automatically; select one menu option by pressing Set when it appears. The display then scrolls the options within that menu. Use to back up and then type over the incorrect characters. You need to cover the exposed rear paper handler with something to prevent the dust from building up. 2 The drum streaks easily and needs cleaning regularly. The Okidata printers actually have a cleaning mode so you can avoid this. 3 After only a month or two the entire sheet will be shaded grey. I finally discovered whythe rubber toner roller that takes up the toner gathered enough paper dust to make its own new surface. This is what was causing fullpage grey shading.

About 20 minutes of rubbing and turning the roller has eliminated this problem, at least for this month. If you can get a refurbished unit you will be much happier. The 600 dpi text is outstanding for both Times New Roman and Courier Final Draft. And the paper tray holds 250 pages. This is one of the first printers Ive ever bought that lives up to the hype. I ordered the Brother from Amazon and it got to my house in Oregon in about a week via ground UPS. It took me ten minutes to get it set up and printing. For. bucks including shipping this printer kicks. No problem with the brother. It prints the entire page in FD docs. Ive only had it for a few days, but I love it. Im running Windows XP Professional with the printer connected to USB, and it works like a charm. The output is excellent. Text, graphicsit all comes out superfast and crisp. I think its a great bargain. The driver for Windows XP has some quirks, though. For example, it does not support printing text in grayscales graphics print fine in grayscales. I was able to resolve this by using the driver for the HP LaserJet 5L, which the Brother seems to be compatible with. Also, in some applications e.g. Streets and Trips 2002, some text is printed mirrored resolved by using the HP 5L driver. Other than that, though, Ive been extremely happy with this printer. Set up was easy in fact, it was easier due to my using Linux. No drivers to install.
